3RD SUNDAY LESSON: "JESUS: THE BREAD OF LIFE" – JOHN 6:25-40

MONDAY – JANUARY 11TH

JOHN 6:22-24 **LEARN JEREMIAN 32:27**

1. What does 'the next day' refer to (look at previous verses)?

2. What, according to verse 22, do the people who remained on the other side of the sea discover the next day?

3. What particular place did the boats from Tiberias come near to?

4. What did the people do when they saw that Jesus and His disciples were no longer there?

5. For what purpose do they do this (your answer to #4)?

TUESDAY – JANUARY 12TH

JOHN 6:25-30 **LEARN JEREMIAH 32:27**

1. What do the people ask Jesus once they have found Him?

2. What do you believe Jesus means when He tells them 'Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles'?

3. For what reason does Jesus say the people really sought after Him?

4. What does Jesus mean when He tells them 'labor not for the meat that perisheth'?

5. Explain what Jesus says in verse 27 that the Son of man shall give.

6. What does the phrase 'for Him hath God the Father sealed' mean?

7. How do the people respond to Jesus' statement that they are to work for the food that endures unto everlasting life'?

8. Explain Jesus' response to their question.

9. What do the people tell Jesus they need in order to believe Him?

10. Look at John 2:18, what request do the Jews make of Jesus?

11. Look at John 4:48, what statement does Jesus make here?

12. Look at Luke 11:29, how does Jesus describe that generation and why does He describe them thus?

13. Look at I Corinthians 1:22-23, what does Paul say the Jews require?

14. How does Paul describe the Jews response to the preaching of the gospel (Christ crucified)?

WEDNESDAY – JANUARY 13TH

JOHN 6:31-40 LEARN JEREMIAH 32:27

1. What in verse 31 lets you know the people's minds were still on physical food?

2. What does Jesus mean when He tells the people that Moses did not give them bread from heaven (v. 32)?

3. What does Jesus mean when He says 'my Father giveth you the *true bread from heaven*'?

4. Do you believe the people understood what Jesus was teaching them about the bread of heaven when they asked in verse 34 'give us this bread always'; explain your answer?

5. What is the significance of Jesus' statement 'I am the bread of life'?

6. As the bread of life, what does Jesus say about those who come to Him and believe on Him?

7. What, according to verse 36, does Jesus say He has already told them that He knows about them?

8. What does Jesus, according to verse 37, convey as His actions toward those that come to Him?

9. **Explain** what Jesus says His Father's will is in verse 39.

10. **Explain** what Jesus says the will of the Father is in verse 40.

THURSDAY – JANUARY 14TH

JOHN 6:41-52 LEARN JEREMIAH 32:27

1. What is the reaction of the Jews to Jesus' statement 'I am the bread which came down from heaven'?

2. What does Jesus tell the Jews to do in verse 43?

3. What do you believe it means that no man comes to Jesus except the Father draws him?

4. Who, according to verse 46, has seen God?

5. Jesus says in verse 47, 'he that believeth on me...', what does it mean to believe on Jesus?

6. What does Jesus say about those who believe on Him?

7. Although the forefathers of the Jews ate bread in the wilderness, what happened to them?

8. **Explain** what Jesus means in verse 51 'the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world'.

9. How do the Jews respond to Jesus' statement that He gives His flesh?

FRIDAY – JANUARY 15TH

JEREMIAH 31:3; HOSEA 11:4 LEARN JEREMIAH 32:27

1. Explain how God said He has loved Israel (Jer. 31:3).

2. Explain how God says He has drawn Israel to Himself.

3. What does it mean that God has 'drawn' them? Remember Jesus' statement in John 6:44.

4. Look at Hosea 11:4, what do the 'cords of a man' refer to?

5. Explain how God says He drew His people unto Himself.

6. What does it mean that He took of the 'yoke on their jaws'?

7. What does the Lord say He laid (stooped down) and gave the people?
