MONDAY – OCTOBER 12TH

EXODUS 23:20-33 LEARN PSALM 46:10

1. Who does the LORD promise to send ahead of His people?

2. Explain the purpose for which the LORD promises to do.

3. What warning is given to the people concerning him (your answer to #1) and why is the warning given?

4. What promise is given if the people will obey his (your answer to #1) voice?

5. What does the LORD mean in verse 23 concerning the nations in Canaan that He will 'cut them off'?

6. Sum up the instructions the LORD gives His people concerning the gods of the Canaanites.

7. As the LORD tells the people of the blessings He will provide as they serve Him, what does it mean 'there shall nothing cast their young' (v. 26)?

8. Explain what it means in verse 27 that 'I will send my fear before thee'.

9. What does the phrase 'I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee' mean (v. 27)?

10. Sum up how the LORD says He will drive out their enemies in verses 29-30.

11. Where does the LORD say He will set the borders (boundaries) of the land of Israel (v. 31)?

12. What prohibition is mentioned in verse 32?

13. Why are God's people not to allow the Canaanites to dwell in the promised land?

7. What did the twelve pillars represent?

8. What did Moses send the young men to do?

9. What does verse 6 say Moses does with the animal's blood?

10. What does Moses do with the book of the covenant?

11. What do the people do when Moses reads the book of the covenant?

12. What does verse 8 say Moses does with the blood?

13. What do Moses and those who went up the mountain with him see when they get up the mount?

14. What is the meaning behind the phrase 'upon the nobles of the children of Israel *he laid not His hand*'?

THURSDAY – OCTOBER 15TH**HEBREWS 9:1-14 LEARN PSALM 46:10**

1. To what does 'the first covenant' refer?

2. What does it mean that the first covenant had...
 - a. Ordinances of divine service

 - b. A worldly sanctuary

3. What, according to verse 2, was in the tabernacle in the place called 'the sanctuary'?

4. Describe what was in the portion of the tabernacle called 'the Holiest of all'.

5. How often does verse 6 say the priests went into the holy place (first part of the tabernacle)?

6. Who was it that went into the second part of the tabernacle (the Holiest of all), and for what purpose did they go in?

7. Explain what it means in verse 8 that 'the Holy Ghost signifying that the *way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest while as the first tabernacle was yet standing*'.

8. Although gifts and sacrifices were made under the old covenant in the tabernacle, what were those gifts and sacrifices unable to do?

9. Explain the significance of 'Christ being come a high priest...' in context.

10. The high priest of the old covenant entered the Most Holy Place with the blood of goats and calves, how did Christ-under the new covenant, enter?

11. How often did Christ (have to) enter the Most Holy Place?

12. What did His entering in obtain for us?

FRIDAY – OCTOBER 16TH**HEBREWS 9:15-23 LEARN PSALM 46:10**

1. What, according to verse 15, is Christ the mediator of?

2. Explain what it means that Christ is mediator and explain His role as mediator.

3. The word testament in verse 16 refers to a will, what is necessary in order for a will to be enforced?

4. The word covenant in verse 18 refers to a covenant, how does verse 18 say the first covenant was dedicated?

5. What does the word 'precept' mean in verse 19?

6. What happened when Moses had spoken all the precepts of the law to the people?

7. What does the law require that all things be purged (cleansed) by?

8. What does it mean that 'without shedding of blood is no remission'?
